1. Winter Sports:

A/B Basketball - Coaches were pleased to have banners and patches available for distribution at the All-League meeting.

  - E. Softball David asked for clarification of need of a coach as the League Rep and date and place of the All-League meeting.
  - F. Swimming / Diving
    - i. David asked if it was possible to change the start time for League swimming finals May 1 st from 9 am to 1 pm. The reason for the change was to accommodate students taking S.A.T. test on that Saturday. After discussion it was decided to leave the time as scheduled.
