H. Track

IV Schedules 2007 – 2008

- A. Wrestling, Softball/Badminton, Baseball and Soccer were presented.
- B. A new soccer schedule was adopted that has a week for Spring Break with no scheduled competition.
 - 1. Bob presented 2 options with starting date either Monday or Wednesday.
 - 2. Vote 5 1 (Armijo) for Option 1. Start date Monday March 19, 2008.
- V Section Back Up -- The Section has not sent out Back-Up materials as of this meeting.
 - A. Fall Sports Starting Date. There are two proposals, 3A and 4, which will be voted on April 25th.
 - 1. Proposal 4 is everything remains the same. Start date will be August 18. First football game is September 12; Last game is November 14.
