Athletic Council

I Fall Sports
A. Football

B. Volleyball
3. All League selection and meeting will be Thursday, November $2^{\text {nd }}$.
4. Play-off brackets by power rating should be on the Section site by Friday, November $3^{\text {rd }}$.
C. Soccer
5. The All League meeting was held on Monday, October $30^{\text {th }}$. All League selection was tabled until the Armijo protest of an ineligible player was resolved.
6. Officials continue to be a coaches' concern.
a. Coaches believe the official should remain on the field untl the "handshakes" are concluded.
