- B. Realignment Update: Barb provided information
- Realignment process takes place every 4 years to provide balance.
 - Criteria for alignment would primarily be:
 - Equity
 - Scope of Program
 - School Enrollment size
 - Sports with competitive equity: football, volleyball, boys/girls soccer, boys/girls basketball, baseball, softball and boys/girls water polo
 - Proposed alignment from 1st reading: Wood/Armijo to SCAC, Bethel/Vallejo to MEL. Discussed proposal of teams switched. Need to clarify possible reasoning. Competitive equity in some cases same rating.
 - Proposed having a meeting between SCAC/MEL principals to develop their proposal to the section.
 - Section stated that the vote must be 12-0 to be heard.
 - Feelings were that Armijo is a scapegoat to justify Wood switch to the SCAC from the MEL.
 - Our league position is to remain intact with all existing schools.
 - The following schools were asked to contact a SCAC school to discuss the issue.

 - Wood/Benicia
