Commissioner Joan Mumaugh called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m.

Present: All Athletic Directors were present except

I Winter Sports

A. Basketball –

1. The all league meeting will be Monday February 18 in the Armijo High health room. The girls' coaches will be at 6:00 pm and the boys' coaches will meet at 7:00 pm.

2. Senior All-star game still does not have an official date yet. Mark Wudel will organize the event as the MEL representative. The host school keeps any snack bar revenue however the gate receipts are used for game expenses.

B. Wrestling –

The league meet will be Saturday February 9th at Wood High school; weigh-in are 7:00am and the meet will start at 9:00am. All proceeds after acceptable expenses (see MEL bylaw 0.26) will be sent to the league along with the financial statement.

II Spring Sports –

A. Swimming

1. Armijo is still in the process of trying to find a coach. John Lammon will notify the commissioner as to the status of their program.

2. There was some discussion at the pre-season meeting regarding the depth of the Vacaville pool at the shallow end. At this point the ADs determined that the pool is usable as it has been in all previous years.

B. Track
