Minutes Board of Managers Rodriguez High Conference Room September 2, 2015

I Opening

A. Present:

- B. Mike Pearson called the meeting to order at 9:02. Each member introduced themselves to the group.
- C. Armijo motioned to accept the minutes of April 22, 2015 as posted. Second by Vacaville. Vote was unanimous.

II Recommended Action

A. Proposed Budget

The proposed budget for 2015-16 was distributed.

- 1. Joan suggested that a line item of "Charge Back of Section Fees" be added to the income area of the budget to insure that there were starting funds at the beginning of the school year.
- 2. Joan explained the two ways the charge back could be handled: 1) each school pay 1/6th of the total Section fees charged to the league, or 2) each school could be charged according to their participation.
- 3. After a short discussion of charge back methods, Vacaville motioned that each school be assessed 1/6th of the section playoff fees billed to the league. Vintage seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous
- 4. Armijo then motioned to accept the budget for 2015-16 as proposed with the addition correction. Rodriguez seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous.

B. Wrestling Tournament Admission price

- 1. At the April 22nd meeting, the board discussed the possibility of raising the admission price for the league-wrestling tournament to cover the costs of hosting the tournament. The suggested price would be \$8.00 for adults and \$5.00 for students and seniors. Current price is \$6.00 for adults and \$4.00 for students and seniors.
- 2. Vacaville motioned to increase the admission prices for the MEL wrestling tournament to \$8.00 for adult and \$6.00 for student and senior. Napa seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous.

C. 2016-17 Soccer

- 1. The Section has asked each league to declare what configuration that they want for game days during the new winter soccer season ie: boys and girls soccer play on the same days at opposite sites or boys and girls play on different days such as M/W/F and T/Th.
- 2. After a short discussion it was decided to table the issue until the September 30th Board of Managers meeting so that sites can further identify possible problems and/or solutions.

- 1. Cam Neal reported that the new start time for Tennis was 3:45 (moved from 3:30) according to MEL bylaws. The new time should give students' a few additional minutes in class on match days.
- 2. Kay Nekota stated that the pre-season soccer meeting was being held September 7, at 6:00pm, Vacaville High room T-9. A soccer official will be present to discuss any new rules and review game expectations.
